ORDER OF PUBLICATION

The object of this proceeding is to effectuate a step parent adoption.

Birth Father in this matter has been served by posting pursuant to §8.01-296 of the Code of Virginia. Birth Father was served by posting as an alternative to personal service only because the process server was unable to get an answer to a knock on the door at what we believed was Birth Father's usual place of abode.

§63.2-1203 of the Code of Virginia states that the Circuit Court may grant the Petition for Adoption without consent from a birth parent fifteen days after personal service of the notice of the Petition for adoption on the party or parties whose consent is required, but personal service was not achievable in this current instance; therefore it is herein

ORDERED that JEREMY MICHAEL RUNALDUE appear before this Court on the ^{7th} 28 day of Sept. at 9:00 o'clock and indicate his attitude toward the step parent adoption action or otherwise do what is necessary to protect her interest herein.

It is therefore ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED that the foregoing portion of this Order be published once a week for four successive weeks in the Alexandria Times, a newspaper having general circulation in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, and published therein.
